Applications for new faculty positions
Tenure track faculty positions, beginning summer/fall 2019-2020

The Institute of Earth Sciences (Faculty of Science at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem) seeks outstanding candidates for tenure track faculty positions at all levels for the 2018-19 academic year. Candidates must have a Ph.D. degree in one of the very diverse fields of the Earth sciences and significant post-doctoral experience is highly desired, although we will consider outstanding candidates at early stages of their post-doctoral research.

Evaluation of candidates will be based primarily on originality, demonstrated or potential for performing ground-breaking research, and high commitment for teaching. The candidate's specialization will be considered. However, we will consider any excellent candidate at any field of Earth sciences. i.e., we have priorities to specific fields but excellent candidates of all fields are encouraged to apply. Fitting to the goals of the institute and quality are our first criteria.

Candidates must demonstrate strong interest and track record in research, outstanding academic credentials, and a strong commitment to undergraduate teaching and graduate mentoring and training. Successful candidates are expected to establish and lead an independent research team pursuing a state-of-the-art research program, and to contribute significantly to the undergraduate and graduate teaching programs.

The review of applications will begin on **October 2nd, 2018**, and applicants are strongly encouraged to submit applications by that date, although we will also discuss late applications.

Each application should include (please follow the detailed instructions):

- **Curriculum Vitae** -Please follow the exact instruction here: [see appendix](#)
- Updated **list of publications**, with notes on specific contributions to multi-authored publications - Please follow the exact instruction here: [see appendix](#)
- **Scientific biography** (2-4 pages), where both the previous candidate's work and his/her future plans will be included and connected to the research proposal below
- **Research Proposal** explaining what do you want to do in the next several years.
- **Teaching interests** and specific courses planned
- Previous teaching experience, including evaluation reports (if available)
- PDF files of the three most **representative papers** of your work.
- Recommendation letters from the Ph.D. and postdoctoral advisors. If there are more than one advisor, please ask all of them! These letters should be sent by the advisors directly (not through the candidate) to Prof. Enzel. Make sure that these advisors actually send them asap.
- A list of five experts who may be approached by our Faculty of Science to evaluate the candidate's qualifications for the requested academic position. Please specify the level of your acquaintance with the suggested referees and include at least two fellows with

whom you have not collaborated. **Please do not approach these referees. The institute and the Faculty will decide whom will be approached.**
